Agendum-1

Up-gradation of the Government Approved Part Time and Contractual Whole Time Teachers, Governing Body-appointed Full Time Teachers and the Guest Teachers to the level of State Aided College Teachers Level-I (SACT-I) and Level-II (SACT-II)

The Coordinator of the Internal Quality Assurance cell (IQAC) reported that the Government of West Bengal has issued an order bearing No. 2081-Edn(CS), dated 23.12.2021 [with concurrence of the Finance Department Order bearing No. U.O. No.1232l1 dt.16.08.19 and U.O. No.1644 dt.19.11.2019] in connection with restructuring of service conditions and other benefits for Government approved Part Time teachers (PTTs), Government approved Contractual Whole time teachers (CWTTs) and Guest teachers, in any nomenclature, engaged in different Government/ Government aided colleges in the State of West Bengal up to 13.07.2019.

The IQAC Coordinator further informed the members that the Government has decided to restructure the service conditions along with the change of nomenclature of the aforesaid category of teachers commensurate with their qualifications and period of service rendered in the following manner:

• Part Time Teachers, Contractual Whole Time Teachers and Guest Teachers having qualification for being appointed as teachers in the colleges as prescribed by the University Grants Commission and as followed by the West Bengal College Service Commission, on the date of issuance of this order, will be renamed as State Aided College Teacher, Category-I, and will be entitled for the following remuneration:

- a. Rs. 31,000/- (consolidated) per month for those served the college less than 10 years
- b. Rs. 35,000/-(consolidated) per month for those served the college more than 10 years
- Part Time Teachers, Contractual Whole Time Teachers and Guest Teachers don't having qualification for being appointed as teachers in the colleges as prescribed by the University Grants Commission, and as followed by the West Bengal College Service Commission on the date of issuance of this order, will be renamed as State Aided College Teacher, Category-Il and will be entitled for the following remuneration:
- a. Rs. 20,000/- (consolidated) per month for those served the college less than 10 years
- b. Rs.25,000/- (consolidated) per month for those served the college more than 10 years
- Remuneration of existing Government approved PTTs and CWTTs, who are getting higher remuneration at present, shall be protected
- Remuneration of above mentioned category of teachers will be enhanced
 @ 3% of the total remuneration per year on 1st July of every year
- Such category of teachers will be entitled for Rs. 5.00 Lakh (Five Lakh)
 only on attaining the age of 60 years, provided the teacher concerned has
 rendered service for a period not less than 10 years
- State Aided College Teacher, Category-II, on acquirement of UGC qualifications subsequently will be considered as State Aided College Teacher, Category-I with effect from the date of acquiring such qualification, subject to the approval of DPI, West Bengal.

The Coordinator then requested the members to please note that there are 13 Government Approved Part Time Teachers, 6 Government Approved Contractual Whole Time Teachers, 8 Guest Teachers and 1 GB appointed Full Time Teacher. The IQAC Coordinator further requested the members to adopt an unanimous resolution so that the matter is placed by the Principal

before the Governing Body for its approval followed by submission of the proposal to the Government for up-gradation of all such 28 teachers to SACT (SACT-I or SACT-II) as the case may be.
