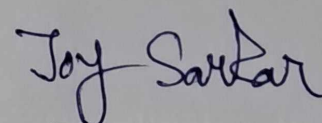

Consideration of the Online Admission Process for admission to the B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. Hons/General/Major Courses for the Academic Session 2022-23 under CBCS.

The Coordinator of the IQAC informed the members that the following will be taken into account in connection with Admission to the B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. Hons/General/Major Courses for the Academic Session 2022-23 under CBCS shall be conducted exclusively in online mode in terms of We Govt. Order bearing No. 507-Edn(CS), dated 30.06.2022.

- Admission to the B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. Hons/General/Major Courses for the Academic Session 2022-23 under CBCS shall be conducted exclusively in online mode in terms of We Govt. Order bearing No. 507-Edn(CS), dated 30.06.2022.
- College portal for online application for admission to the B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. Hons/General/Major Courses for the Academic Session 2022-23 under CBCS has already been opened on 18.07.2022 in terms of We Govt. Order bearing No. 507-Edn(CS), dated 30.06.2022.
- Candidates need not to pay any Application Fee like earlier years
- College portal for online application for admission to the B.A., B.Sc. and B.Com. Hons/General/Major Courses for the Academic Session 2022-23 under CBCS shall remain open till 5th August, 2022 in terms of We Govt. Order bearing No. 507-Edn(CS), dated 30.06.2022.
- Complete list of eligible candidates (Course-wise and Category-wise) will be published on 16th August, 2022 under normal circumstances.
- 1st Admission List will be published prior to 16th August, 2022.
- Admission will commence from 17th August, 2022.

- The candidates accommodated in the Admission List(s) will be at liberty to pay the Admission Fees online and get them admitted to one or more than one courses (as the case may be).
- The admission will be strictly on the basis of merit and in strict observance of (1) Admission Regulation of the Affiliating University (Calcutta University), (2) Intake Capacity, and (3) Reservation Policy of the Government.
- After the admission, the applications of the admitted candidates shall be verified online followed by approval of admission provisionally.
- Admission will continue till 15th September, 2022 in terms of West Bengal Govt. Order bearing No. 507-Edn(CS), dated 30.06.2022.
- Classes will commence on 19th September, 2022 in terms of West Bengal Govt. Order bearing No. 507-Edn(CS), dated 30.06.2022.
- If any discrepancy between the data/information entered and the corresponding document uploaded is noticed at any point of time before registration, the admission of the concerned candidate shall be summarily cancelled.
- The data in the 'system' shall be retrieved as per direction of the affiliating university for Registration.
- At any point of time, any candidate may apply for cancellation of admission exclusively in online mode.
- Applications for cancellation shall be verified by the college online. Subject to the successful verification, 'Admission Cancellation Order' will be issued with an electronic intimation to the concerned candidate (SMS/E-mail). The Admission Cancellation Order may be downloaded from the college website.
- After the issuance of 'Admission Cancellation Order' the candidates will be allowed to apply for refund of Admission Fees in terms of West Bengal Government Order bearing No. 209(29)-Edn(U), 24.07.2017.
- Admission fee will be refunded through 'Direct Transfer' mode.
